

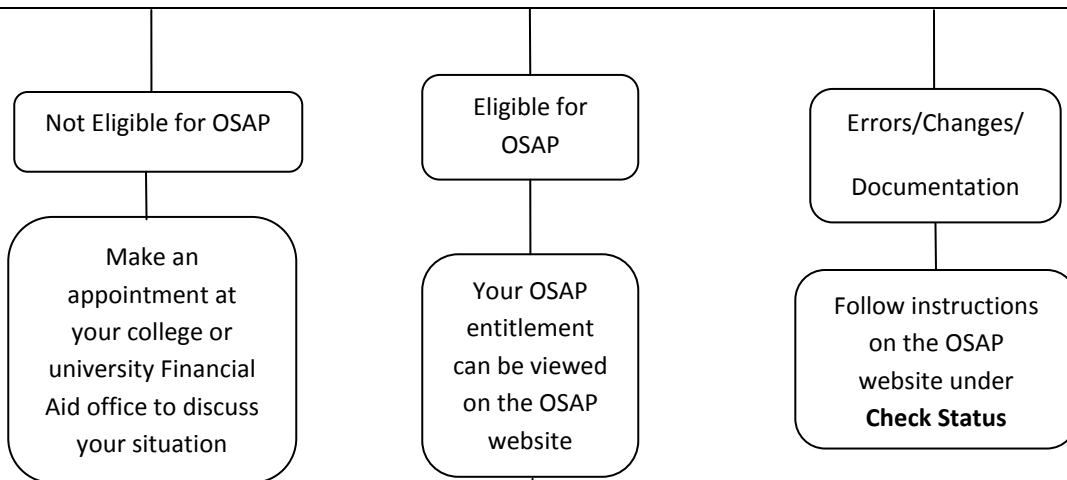
What is the OSAP Process?

Apply online at <http://osap.gov.on.ca>

You will be asked for your OAN number and password

Signature pages may be printed off the web or mailed to you by the Ministry. If mailed, you will receive these forms within 10 days of submitting your on-line application. You, and your parents or spouse, must sign these forms. They **MUST** be returned **immediately** to the Financial Aid and Awards office at your college or university along with any supporting documentation requested at the end of your application. Once submitted, this paperwork completes your OSAP application.

You should periodically check the status of your OSAP application by logging on to the OSAP website and clicking on **Check Status**. You are responsible for making any changes to information after you have submitted your application.



The Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement (MSFAA) is a **lifetime student loan agreement** for **full-time students** that only has to be completed once during your post-secondary studies. The agreement contains the terms and conditions you need to agree to in order to receive and repay your OSAP loan.

The processing of your loan documents by the lender's office can take up to 10 working days after they have been received. You will need to be prepared to pay your own costs e.g. books, living costs, during this processing period.
