

Motorcycle Basics

This is a Canada Safety Council approved program. You will have three hours to spend on a motorcycle, which we provide. You do not need an M1 permit to take this course as no testing is involved.

The course will be taught by accredited and experienced Canada Safety Council instructors and will allow you to gain an understanding of the basics of riding and should help to dispel any concerns that you may have about operating a motorcycle. Classes run rain or shine.

The topics covered include:

- mounting a motorcycle,
- the ready position,
- · controlled braking,
- proper use of eyes,
- locating the controls,
- starting the motorcycle,
- using the gears,
- proper use of the clutch,
- the flat wrist technique,
- proper riding position,
- move off and stop.

Motorcycle Introduction M2

Prerequisite: 16 years of age or older and an M1 permit that MUST be valid for the duration of the course. You MUST show your M1 permit the first class to be allowed entry. We provide the training motorcycles. This course is recognized by the MTO (Ministry of Transportation), and is endorsed by the Canada Safety Council and Insurance Advisory Organization. The focus of the course is on providing you with motorcycle safety information and skills required to advance from the M1 permit to the M2 license. Testing for the M2 license is included in the course. You will be in class for five hours (theory) and on a motorcycle for 14 hours practicing basic and advanced manoeuvres. Classes run rain or shine.

Important

You must provide your own safety approved helmet, gloves with fingers to cover the wrist, leather boots to cover the ankle, ballistic nylon, leather or jean pants and jacket. Ballistic nylon jackets and gloves are the preferred attire for motorcycle riding as they are protective, colorful, water-resistant and more versatile than leather or jean items.

Motorcycle Advanced M2 Exit

Prerequisite: Ministry of Transportation (MTO) M2 license which you have held for a MINI-MUM of 18 months but which is still within the MAXIMUM of five years by the course end date (no exceptions). This course is recognized by the MTO and is designed for the experienced street rider who wants to gain a permanent motorcycle license (M Licence) and learn safety management techniques. The course combines both theory and practical training on the road riding your bike. You will learn defensive driving techniques, refresh your low speed skills, learn vehicle control, perform in traffic situations, practice high speed pattern riding and ride using advanced riding procedures. You must provide a ROADWORTHY two-wheeled motorcycle that can reach at least 100 kilometers per hour, proof of ownership and insurance and your valid M2 license. Testing for the M license is included in the course. If you already have your M license but are looking for a refresher course or one to reduce your insurance rates you should take the Motorcycle, Intro M2 course and not the Motorcycle, Advanced M2 Exit course. Classes run rain or shine.
